



Parental Waiver/ Medical Release/ Code of Conduct

Consent for Medical Treatment (Minor)

As the parent/legal guardian of the player, I hereby give consent for medical care prescribed by duty licensed Doctor of Medicine or Doctor of Dentistry. This care may be given under whatever conditions are necessary to preserve life, limb, or well-being of my dependant.

General Release

I, the parent/legal guardian, of the player, a minor, agree that I and the player will abide by the rules and regulations of the U.S. Youth Soccer (USYS), and its affiliated organizations, and the California Youth Soccer Association, Inc (CYSA), and its affiliated organizations. I, for myself and the player and our respective heirs, administrators and successors, intending to be legally bound, hereby release and indemnify the USYS and CYSA Parties, the owners and operators of the facilities used for the Programs, and their respective directors, officers, employees, agents, and representatives from and against all claims, liabilities, damages, or causes of action arising out of or in connection with the player's participation in the Programs including, without limitation, player's transportation to/from any Program, which transportation is hereby authorized. I further grant the USYS and CYSA Parties the right to use player's name, picture and /or likeness in printed, broadcast and other material concerning the Programs provided such use is related to the player's status as a participant in the Programs.

The most important aspect of PCA is to "Honor the Game." Parents are expected to refrain from yelling, and show respect for coaches and referee's even if you don't agree with them. This sets a healthy and fun environment for your children. All AVYSL parents are expected to sign a PCA agreement that outlines the Personal Coaching Alliance code and conduct that is expected whenever you are on any of our playing fields.
